Continuing Education Credit: Continuing Education credit has been approved for **0.45 live continuing education units (CEUs)/4.5 contact hours of live continuing education.**

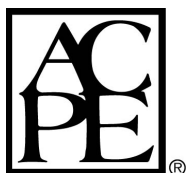
